

## FAQ

1. What is Kids Across America (KAA)?

Kids Across America is a Christian athletic empowering urban youth and their leaders. The KAA experience provides healthy outdoor activities, such as zipline, water sports, athletics, along with great food and camp fires. While utilizing an exemplary staff of collegiate counselors, Biblical values and leadership/character development skills are woven into each activity.

3. Who can attend?

KAA welcomes all youth 10-18 years old. KAA has three different camp sites. Each camp is based on age and independent of one another. A camper in one camp will not be in contact with anyone in the other camps.

KAA 1	10-12 years old
KAA 2	13-14 years old
KAA 3	15-18 years old

4. When does SJC plan to attend?

SJC will attend the second session, June 11<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup>. The departure on the 11th will be at 4:00am with a 2:00am check-in. SJC will return on June 17th around 7:00pm.

5. How much does it cost to attend KAA with SJC?

The cost is \$325.00 per camper. Cost includes KAA fees, medical insurance, snacks, tee shirts (2), meals (2), and travel expenses. There is a non-refundable and non-transferrable deposit of \$50.00. If SJC is unable to secure a slot for your child, your deposit will be fully refunded via check.

6. When are payments due to SJC?

If you will be attending with SJC please do not pay any fees with KAA. All fees are to be paid to SJC. Payments can be made at any time via Givelify. Final payment is due May 15.

7. What is the deadline to sign-up and pay deposit for KAA?  
Sign-up and deposits are now due because of limited availability. Attendance is on a first-come basis. Please confirm availability prior to making a deposit.
8. Are there any discounts if three or more attend from the same household?  
Yes, there is a discount for a family when three or more youth plan to attend. The first and second child will pay the full amount and the third child will pay \$250.00
